

How to do candy_jelly by Issa

Create a transparent canvas 125*115

Use the ellipse select tool and create a circle about 106*100

Fill the circle with a very light grey or white colour. I used white colour. Name this layer as candy **base**

Duplicate the candy base layer and selected this copy layer

Go to filters – noise – spread and set it at 125

Selection layer base and alpha to selection

Selection - invert and go to base copy layer and edit clear. Selection nothing.

Go to colours – invert. Alpha to selection

Create a new transparent layer above this layer and fill this selection with a candy colour. Set the new layer at grain merge. Name this layer **colour**

New from visible

Duplicate the layer visible and set visible copy layer at Screen Layer Mode. You get your first jelly candy.



You can change the colour of the candy :

Close the eyes at two upper layers (visible) and fill the circle with another candy colour and follow the last previous steps:

New from visible

Duplicate the layer visible and set Visible copy layer at Screen Layer Mode.

More realistic effect:

Go to Filters – Distorts – Iwarp and select grow and push it a bit to distort the circle.

You are done.
