






This is the program cover..



( A )Don't forget that after installing GimPac and whenever you open Gimp it will appear in our Taskbar

- 1º - Let's load our Settings ( 1 )
- 2º - Shearch for where we have our Gimp installed.. ( 2 )
- 3º - Here we put our version of Gimp ( 3 )
- 4º - Enable the Delete Button from the Gimp Toolbox ( 4 )
- 5º - Enable GimPack launch box together with Gimp ( 5 )
- 6º - Time in seconds that GimPack takes to close after Gimp ( 6 )
- 7º - Load to check if everything is ok ( 7 )





Let's go where everything happens..

1º - Load into Gimp Files. ( 1 )

2º - Load what we are looking for (Brushes, Gradients, Color palettes,Textures, Fonts) and everything will appear in this Box. ( 2 )

3º - Here we can delete everything, or what we have only selected, ( 3 ) or we can delete it from Gimp ( A )


4º - Here we can Create, ( B ) Install, ( C ) or Uninstall our GimPack Files. ( D )

- 1º - Here we look for our Covers. ( 1 )  
2º - The place where they are. ( 2 )  
3º - Program Cover ( A ), Apply to what we want ( B ), We can add more ( C ), Or remove ( D ), Checking the box. We can change it every time we open Gimp, ( D )
